

EasyIPSetupToolPlus 操作手册

简介

EasyIPSetupToolPlus 是在 Windows PC 上运行的应用软件。

在连接到松下遥控摄像机的 PC 上运行此软件，可检测遥控摄像机或更改设置信息。

主要功能

此软件的主要功能如下：

1.检测松下遥控摄像机并显示所述摄像机信息

在连接到松下遥控摄像机的 PC 上运行此软件，可检测遥控摄像机，

还可以显示 Mac 地址、Ipv4 地址等摄像机信息。

2.快速亮灯

指定遥控摄像机的电源指示灯可以快速亮起。

3. 网络设置

可更改指定遥控摄像机的网络设置信息。

4. Web 界面

可将显示内容切换至指定遥控摄像机的网络屏幕。

5. 自动 IP

可以为指定的遥控摄像机分配连续的 IP 地址。

6. 管理员注册

可以为指定的遥控摄像机注册管理员帐户。

7. 固件升级

已连接的遥控摄像机的固件版本可以升级。

8. 激活

您可以激活各种付费许可证。

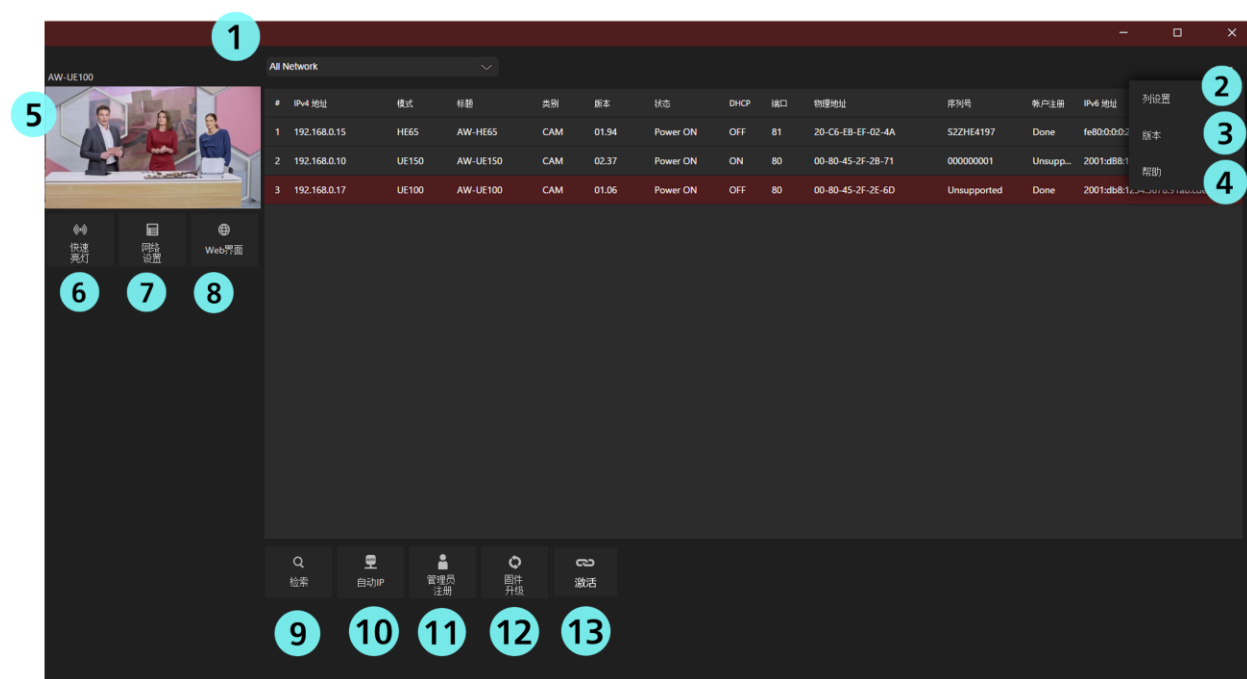

① IPv4 地址

显示遥控摄像机的 Ipv4 地址。

单击 IPv4 地址，可以按 IPv4 地址的升序或降序对摄像机列表进行排序。

② 模式

显示遥控摄像机的型号名称。

单击模式，可以按型号对摄像机列表进行排序。

③ 标题

显示遥控摄像机的标题。

单击标题，可以按标题的升序或降序对摄像机列表进行排序。

④ 类别

显示设备类别。

如果是遥控摄像机，则显示 CAM。

单击类别，可以按类别对摄像机列表进行排序。

⑤ 版本

显示遥控摄像机的固件版本。

快速亮灯

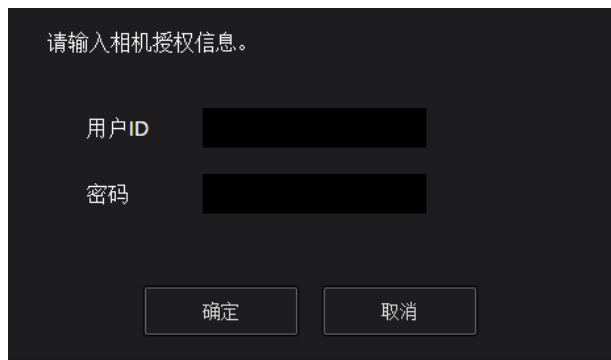

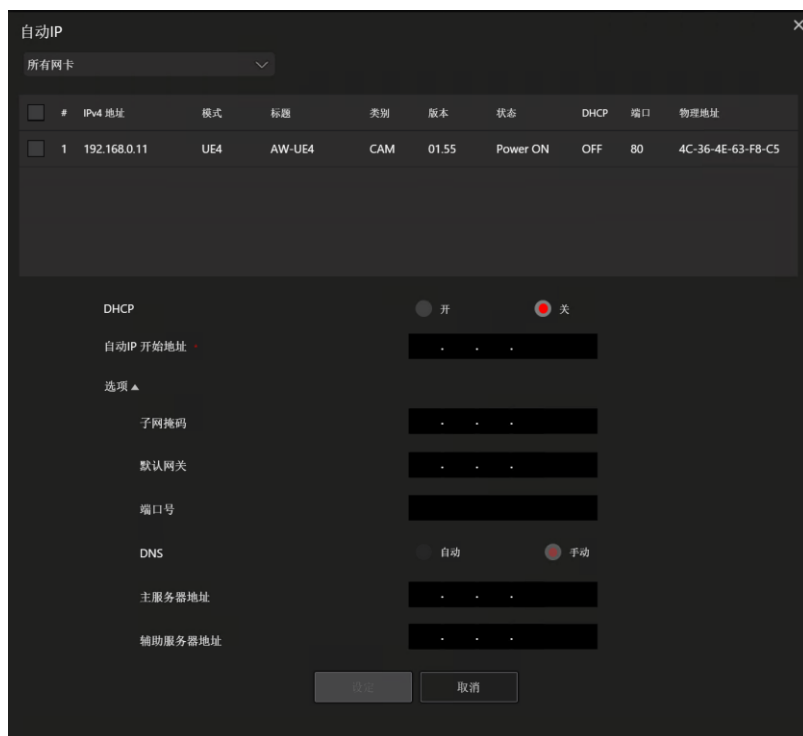

- DHCP 选择 OFF 时

192.168.0.10, 192.168.0.11, 192.168.0.12, ...。

- DHCP 选择 ON 时

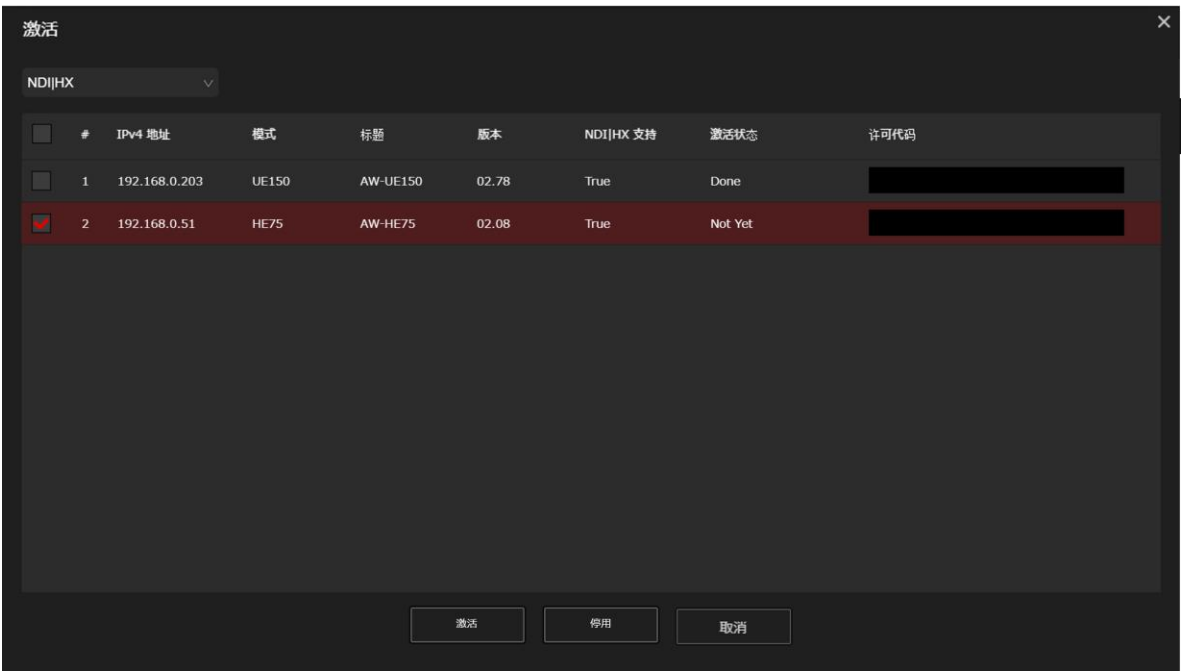

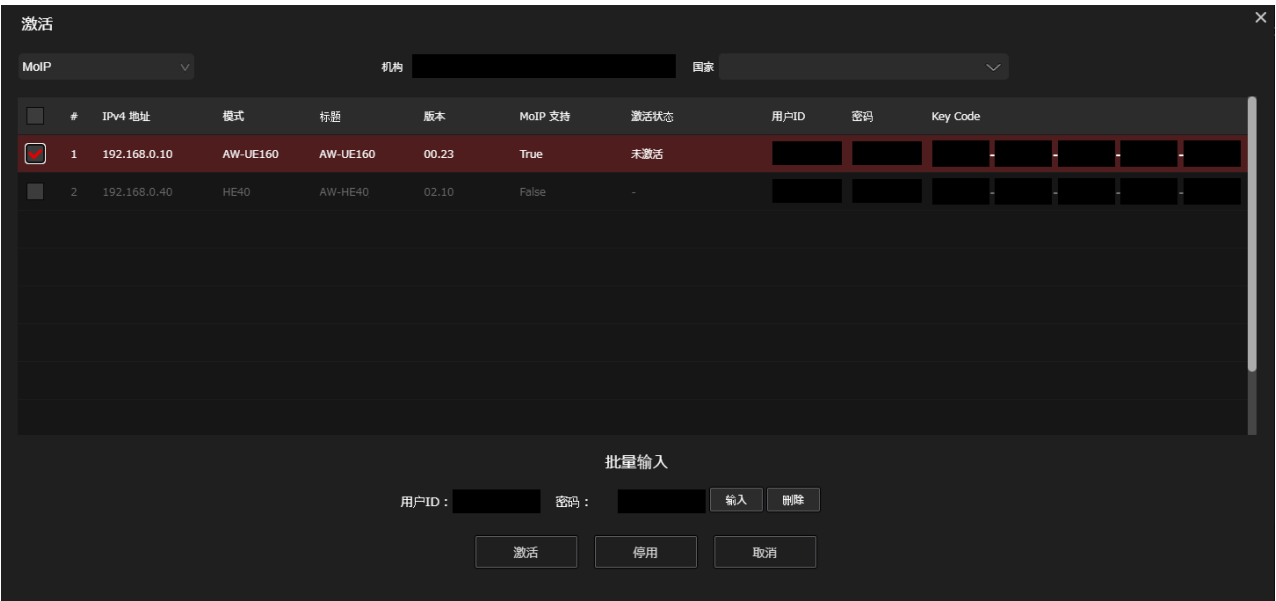
