

EasyIPSetupToolPlus 操作説明書

はじめに

EasyIPSetupToolPlus は、Windows PC 上で動作するアプリケーションソフトウェアです。

Panasonic 製カメラが接続された PC で本ソフトウェアを動作させることにより、カメラの検出や設定情報の変更を行うことができます。

主な機能

本ソフトウェアの主な機能は次の通りです。

1. パナソニック製カメラの検出・カメラ情報表示

Panasonic 製カメラが接続された PC で本ソフトウェアを動作させることにより、カメラを検出することができます。また、MacAddress, Ipv4 Address 等のカメラ情報を表示することが可能です。

2. Identify

指定したカメラの電源ランプを高速点灯することができます。

3. Network Settings

指定したカメラのネットワーク設定情報を変更することができます。

4. Web GUI

指定したカメラの Web 画面に遷移することができます。

5. Auto IP

指定したカメラの IP アドレスを連続したアドレスに割り当てることができます。

6. Administrator Registration

指定したカメラに管理者アカウントを登録することができます。

7. Firmware Update

接続されたカメラのファームウェアをバージョンアップすることができます。

8. Activation

各種有償ライセンスのアクティベーションを行うことができます。

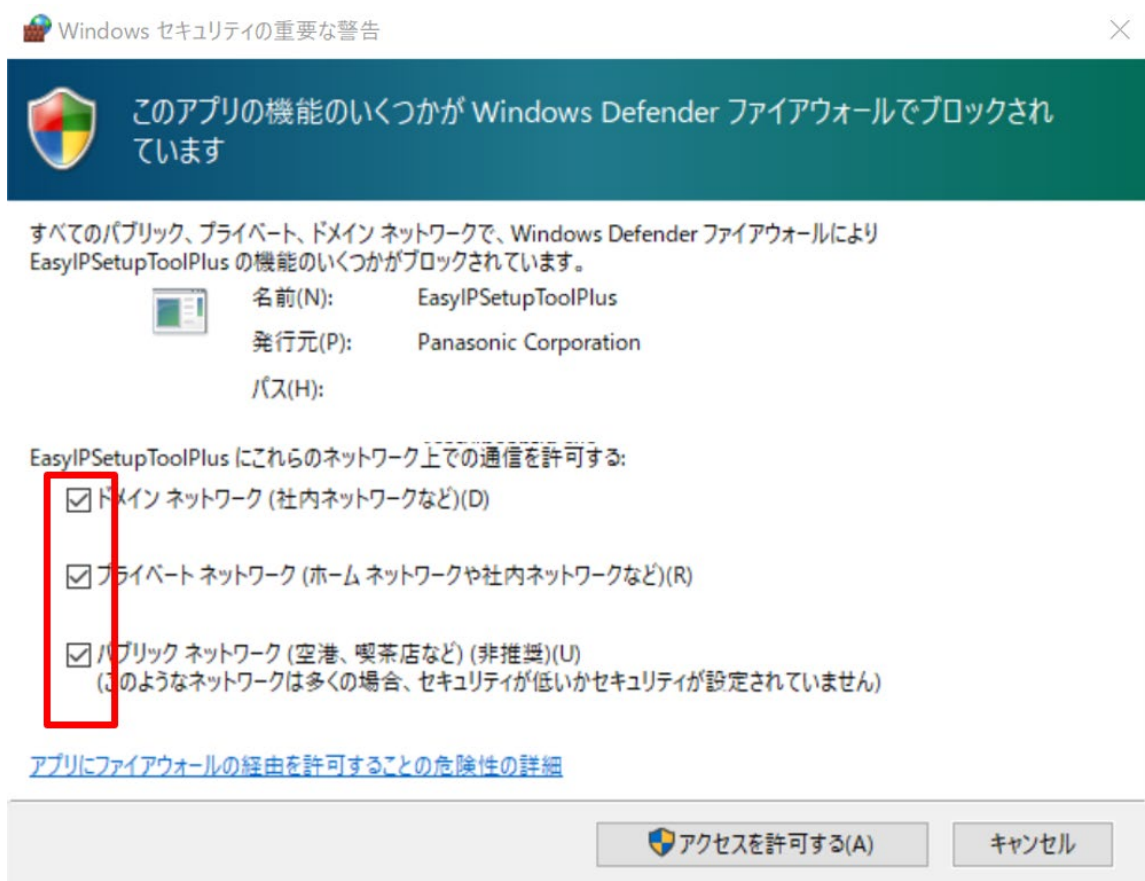

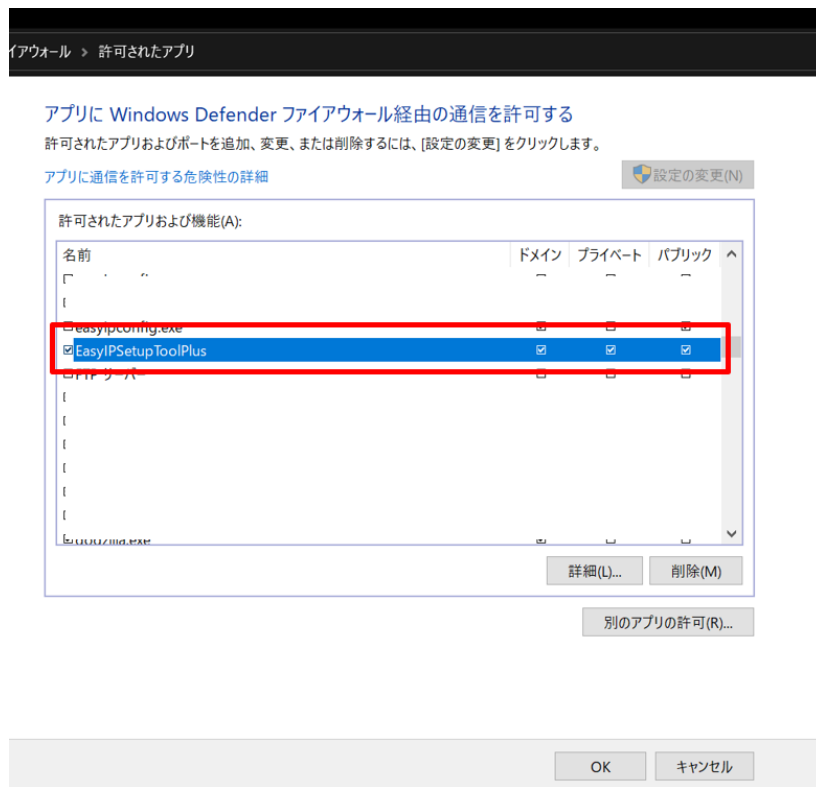


2.ファイアウォールによるアプリケーションの許可を開きます。

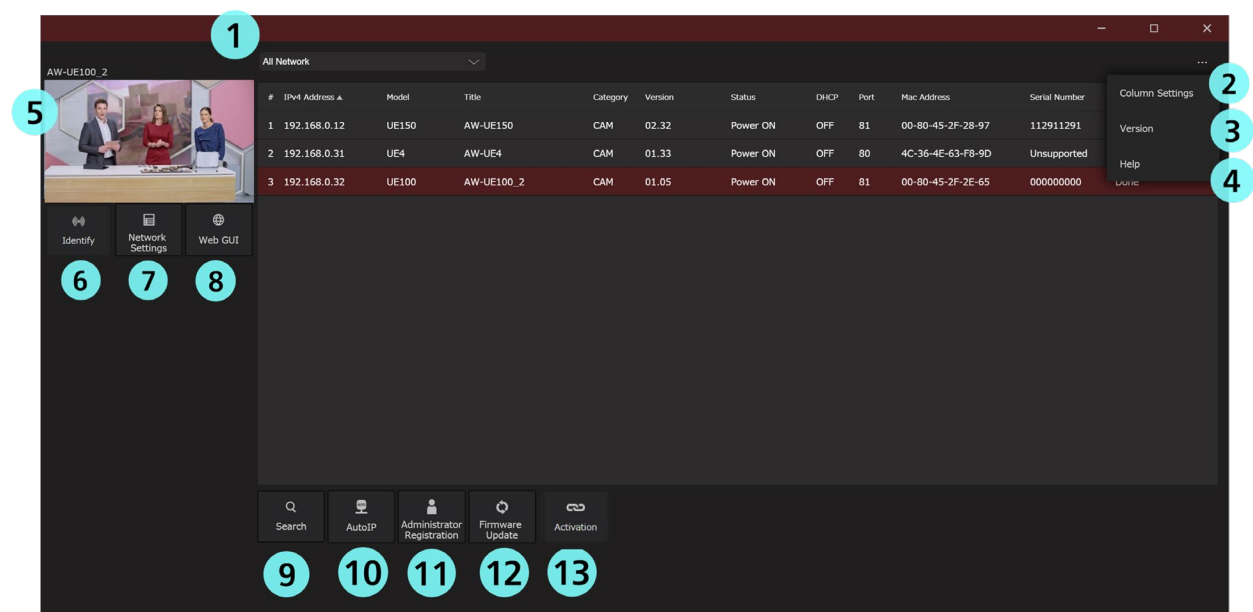


4.EasyIPSetupToolPlus を再起動すると、カメラの検出が正常に行われます。

① IPv4 Address

カメラのIPv4Addressを表示します。

IPv4 Address をクリックすることで、カメラ一覧を IPv4 Address の昇順、または降順に並び替えることができます。

② Model

カメラのモデル名を表示します。

Model をクリックすることで、カメラ一覧を Model 毎の表示に並び替えることができます。

③ Title

カメラのタイトルを表示します。

Title をクリックすることで、カメラ一覧を Title の昇順、または降順に並び替えることができます。

④ Category

機器カテゴリを表示します。

カメラの場合、CAM と表示されます。

Category をクリックすることで、カメラ一覧を CAM 毎の表示に並び替えることができます。

⑤ FW Version

カメラのファームウェアバージョンを表示します。

※カメラのユーザー認証が ON の場合、情報を取得することができません。

⑥ Status

カメラの状態を表示します。

PowerON : 電源 ON Standby : スタンバイ状態

※カメラのユーザー認証が ON の場合、情報を取得することができません。

Status をクリックすることで、カメラ一覧を Status 毎の表示に並び替えることができます。

⑦ DHCP

カメラのネットワーク設定情報を表示します。

ON : DHCP 設定 OFF : 固定 IP 設定

DHCP をクリックすることで、カメラ一覧を DHCP 毎の表示に並び替えることができます。

⑧ Port

カメラのポート番号を表示します。

Port をクリックすることで、カメラ一覧をポート番号の昇順、または降順に並び替えることができます。

⑨ Mac Address

カメラの MacAddress を表示します。

⑩ Serial Number

カメラのシリアル番号を表示します。

※カメラのユーザー認証が ON の場合、情報を取得することができません。

⑪ Administrator Registration

管理者アカウントの設定情報を表示します。

Done : 設定済み None : 未設定

Administrator Registration をクリックすることで、カメラ一覧を Administrator Registration 毎の表示に並び替えることができます。

⑫ IPv6Address

カメラの IPv6Address を表示します。

IPv6 Address をクリックすることで、カメラ一覧を IPv6 Address の昇順、または降順に並び替えることができます。

⑬ Web 画面への遷移

ダブルクリックを行うことで、選択したカメラの Web 画面に遷移することができます。

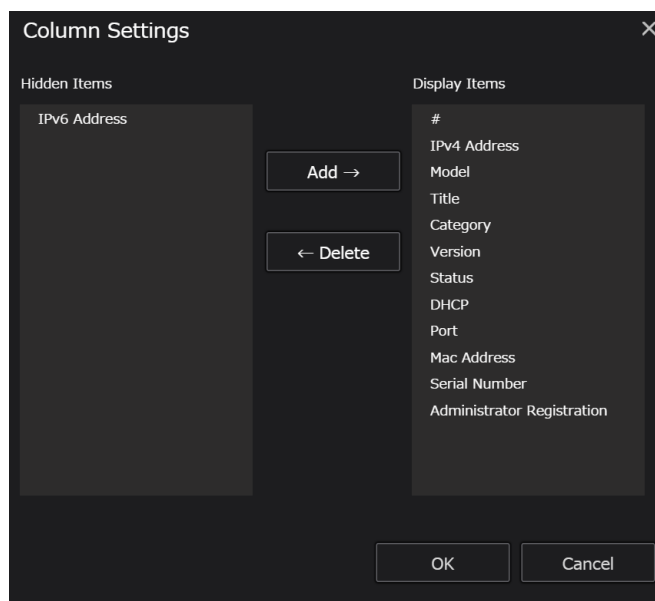

2. Delete ボタンを押します。



Identify







 - symbols(!#\$%&'()*+,-./?@[\\]^_`~)
- Set the password which does not include the user name.
- It is recommended to change the password periodically.



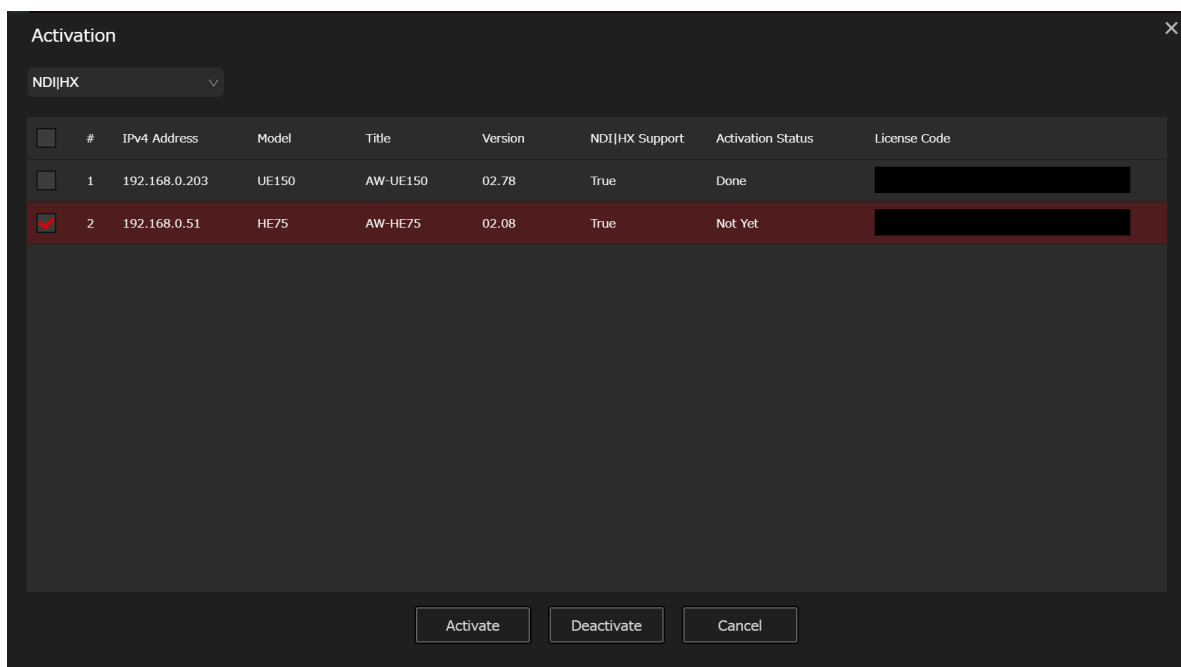

as the successor of the GNU Library Public License, version 2, hence

Preamble

The licenses for most software are designed to take away your
freedom to share and change it. By contrast, the GNU General Public
Licenses are intended to guarantee your freedom to share and change
free software--to make sure the software is free for all its users.

This license, the Lesser General Public License, applies to some
specially designated software packages--typically libraries--of the
Free Software Foundation and other authors who decide to use it. You
can use it too, but we suggest you first think carefully about whether
this license or the ordinary General Public License is the better
strategy to use in any particular case, based on the explanations below.

When we speak of free software, we are referring to freedom of use,
not price. Our General Public Licenses are designed to make sure that
you have the freedom to distribute copies of free software (and charge
for this service if you wish); that you receive source code or can get
it if you want it; that you can change the software and use pieces of
it in new free programs; and that you are informed that you can do
these things.

To protect your rights, we need to make restrictions that forbid
distributors to deny you these rights or to ask you to surrender these
rights. These restrictions translate to certain responsibilities for
you if you distribute copies of the library or if you modify it.
