Since V2.3.29 for P2 Viewer Plus, installation of QuickTime is no longer required.

Even if QuickTime is installed, P2 Viewer Plus works as usual.

If it is not installed, you can use an external player to playback a clip on P2 Viewer Plus by double-clicking a clip

The supported external player is Media Player Classic Black Edition (MPC-BE).

This document describes differences in operation when QuickTime is not installed and how to install the external player.




2. Extract the ZIP file, launch the installer, and follow the instructions to install.
