

AW-HE40 – Backup Procedure for Setting Data

★ You can save the camera's setting data onto a PC, or upload the saved setting data to another camera if you need to, for example, replace the camera with another one. The setting data can be backed up only by the WEB Screen operations.

【Procedure for Saving (Downloading) the Setting Data】

• Start the WEB Screen and follow the procedure below to save the setting data. – (See the figure below (yellow arrows on AW-HE40 WEB Screen))

Procedure: [Setup] > [Maintenance] > [Backup] > Select [Camera] or [Network] at Config data type (* See next page)

⇒ Click [Execute] button at Download. ⇒ Specify the destination to save the data on the save-destination dialog box.

<Note>

- If the login screen appears, please enter the user name and password.
- It takes approx. 10 – 30 seconds until the save-destination dialog box is shown after [Execute] button is clicked.
- Downloading the setting file may cause the camera to reboot.

【Procedure for Uploading the Setting Data】

• Start the WEB Screen and follow the procedure below to upload the setting data. – (See the figure below (red arrows on AW-HE40 WEB Screen))

Procedure: Click Upload [Browse]. ⇒ Select the file you desire to upload on the dialog box.

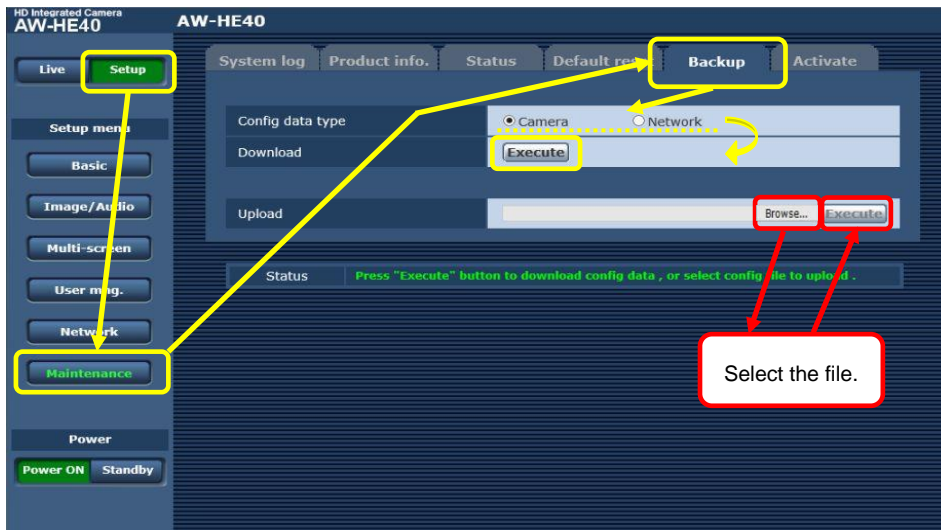
⇒ Click [Execute]. ⇒ Click [OK] on the message dialog box. ⇒ Upload process will start.

⇒ After the upload is completed, click [OK] on the message dialog box to reboot the camera.

<Note>

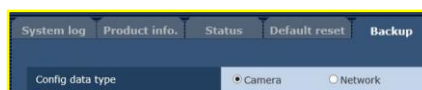
- Data to be uploaded has to be the file downloaded from the same model (AW-HE40).
- If you change the name of the setting file, you may not be able to upload that file.
- Please do not turn off the camera during the download/upload process.

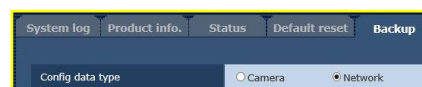

★ It is possible to upload the saved setting data to a camera with a different firmware version, but the functions added by updating the firmware version cannot be uploaded together. So the firmware updating has to be performed on each camera.
